

**TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN
MINUTES OF CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING
June 16, 2009**

A regular meeting of the Township of Seguin Cemetery Committee was held on June 16, 2009 at the Township of Seguin Municipal Office. After the meeting was called to order the Chair requested approval of the agenda.

The Chair requested that any disclosures of pecuniary interest be declared. There were no disclosures of pecuniary interest.

The Committee reviewed a maintenance problem at Humphrey-Rosseau Cemetery that has been rectified. It was noted that due to the heavy clay soil in this cemetery, the frost has a tendency to remain in the ground for a longer period of time in the spring.

The Committee reviewed the cemetery maintenance report prepared by Gord Brown, Facilities Supervisor. A request was made to repair the entry gate at Christie Memorial as soon as possible to permit access to the cemetery from Hwy 518 or remove the gate and place it to one side. Also, a request was made to level the ground in the Frank and Florence Forbes cemetery lot at Christie Memorial.

Councillor Jacklin very kindly offered to donate his time and tandem truck to deliver screened topsoil to the cemeteries. (Foley Memorial and Christie Memorial require one load each) The Committee was advised that attempts are being made to hire a contractor to remove the old paint from the fence at Foley Memorial and repaint the fence. If this is not possible the rental of an air compressor will be investigated.

The Committee reviewed the invoices charged to Cemeteries.
