



# Fire Season Extends from April 1 – October 31

## **DAYTIME BURNING REQUIRES A PERMIT**

**Open Burning (without a permit) is allowed only *if*:**

- The Fire Hazard Rating is **LOW** or **MODERATE**.
- The fire is tended by a responsible person who has adequate tools or water to contain the fire.
- The fire is ignited 2 hours before sunset or later.
- And is extinguished 2 hours after sunrise or earlier.
- The pile is less than 2 meters by 2 meters.
- The fire is at least 2 meters away from flammable materials.

During **HIGH** Fire Hazard Rating, No Open Burning is allowed, including Incinerators. Camp fires are allowed for cooking and warmth only. Flame size can be no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet.

During **EXTREME** Fire Rating, **NO BURNING IS ALLOWED**.

Incinerators are required to have a mesh cover to eliminate sparks.
